RESOLUTION #19 OF 2010 WORKPLACE VIOLENCE PREVENTION POLICY

<u>WHEREAS</u>, Section 27-b of the New York State Labor Law requires employers to perform a risk evaluation at each worksite and to develop and implement programs to prevent and minimize workplace violence caused by assaults and homicides; and

<u>WHEREAS</u>, the goal is to ensure that the risk of workplace assaults and homicides are regularly evaluated by public employers and that programs are implemented to prevent and minimize workplace violence; and

<u>WHEREAS</u>, public employers with a combined total of 20 or more full-time employees are required to develop and implement a written workplace violence prevention program and provide employee training on workplace violence preventions measures and other information contained within the employers written program; and

WHEREAS, the evaluation and education, and written workplace violence prevention program policy has been completed; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Town of Deerpark hereby adopts the Workplace Violence Prevention Policy dated March 2010.
