RESOLUTION #1 OF 2011

Resolution Recognizing the Collective Bargaining Agent for Certain Employees in the Town of Deer Park Highway Department

WHEREAS, the Laborers' International Union of North America Local 17 has requested that the Town of Deer Park recognize it as the exclusive collective bargaining representative for certain employees of the Town of Deer Park highway department in determining the terms and conditions of employment and the administration of grievances; and,

WHEREAS, it is believed that Laborers' International Union of North America Local 17 has majority interest among the full-time laborers and equipment operators employed in the Town of Deer Park Highway Department, and

WHEREAS, the Town Board has been advised by its labor relations consultant that the New York State Public Employment Relations Board would certify Laborers' International Union of North America Local 17 if a certification petition was filed;

BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED, that in accordance with Article 14 of the Civil Service Law (the Public Employees' Fair Employment Act) Section 204.1, the Town of Deer Park recognizes Laborers' International Union of North America Local 17 as the exclusive collective bargaining representative for all full-time laborers and equipment operators employed in the Town of Deer Park Highway Department who regularly perform year-round work operating equipment and/or repairing and maintaining Highway Department vehicles, equipment, or facilities; and

BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED, that the following titles within the Town of Deer Park Highway Department are excluded from the bargaining unit: Superintendent of Highways, Deputy Superintendent of Highways, temporary employees, seasonal employees, and clerical employees.
