## **RESOLUTION #41 OF 2011** **Additions to the Deerpark Hazard Mitigation Plan**

**WHEREAS**, the Town of Deerpark Hazard Mitigation Plan has been prepared in accordance with the Disaster Mitigation Act of 2000 and 44 CFR Part 201; and

**WHEREAS**, the Town of Deerpark is a local unit of government that has afforded the citizens an opportunity to comment and provide input in the Plan and the actions in the Plan; and

**WHEREAS**, the Town of Deerpark has adopted a resolution which officially adopts the plan; and

**WHEREAS**, Town of Deerpark officials have identified additional action areas and information which need to be incorporated into the existing plan after results from the recent Tropical Storms of Irene and Lee of 2011;

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE DEERPARK TOWN BOARD** hereby adds to the existing Hazard Mitigation Plan the following priority areas for future mitigation action to include but not limited to culvert replacement/rehabilitation/upgrades, bank stabilization, dredging, catch basin replacement, and improvement of drainage areas:

**Misty Meadows Development**: Cora Rose Lane and Dandee Circle

**Deerpark Manor Development**: Manor Lane, Maple Lane, Elm Street, Apple Lane, Oak Circle, County Route 61

**Pinekill Creek**

**Myers Grove Development**: 1<sup>st</sup> Street, 2<sup>nd</sup> Street, 3<sup>rd</sup> Street, 4th Street, 5<sup>th</sup> Street, Myers Road, Grove Street, Shore Drive, Guymard Turnpike

**Big Pond Road, Edgewater Lane, Rivers Edge Road, Galley Hill Road**

These actions listed above apply to existing structures, flooding and severe storm hazard mitigation, town as lead agency, moderate to high cost estimate, potential funding sources to include FEMA grant programs and local funding, and short to medium term timeframe, and;

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the approved minutes of the Public Hearing for Tropical Storms Irene and Lee of 2011, held on Monday, September 26, 2011 be incorporated into the Deerpark Hazard Mitigation Plan;

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the Damage Assessment Reports for Tropical Storms Irene and Lee of 2011, be incorporated into the Deerpark Hazard Mitigation Plan;

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the Town Engineer be added as a member of the Deerpark Hazard Mitigation Plan Team.
