Resolution 2-2012
Opposition to Gas Compressor

Deerpark supports development of public infrastructure, including natural gas infrastructure. However, Deerpark believes such development must be done in a way that takes into account the environmental, financial, and other impacts of such development.

The Deerpark Town Board and its consultants have reviewed the Wagoner/Neversink Alternative and does not believe that it is a viable option, as it would have a far greater environmental impact on the residents of Orange County and more significantly, the residents of the Town of Deerpark. A large portion of the proposed 7.2 miles of pipeline upgrade is located in very steep and rugged portion of the Town.

Also, according to the Orange County IDA PILOT agreement, Deerpark will not receive any more revenue if Millennium replaces the Neversink segment of the line than if it built the Minisink Compressor Station.

For these reasons, Deerpark asks FERC to approve the Minisink Compressor Station proposal which has the least environmental impact, and will get the needed infrastructure built to serve the energy needs of our region.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TOWN BOARD that the Town of Deerpark adopts Resolution 2-2012.
