RESOLUTION #34 OF 2010 FEE SCHEDULE CHANGES FOR USE OF SPACE PARK AND TOWN PARKS

<u>WHEREAS</u>, the Town of Deerpark currently rents out the use of Harriet Space Park, and

<u>WHEREAS</u>, the Town of Deerpark also permits the use of various other townowned properties that are deemed as parks per Local Law 1 of 2004, and

WHEREAS, clean up and trash removal from Space Park, after private events, has become a problem, and

WHEREAS, the Town currently charges residents and non-residents for the use of this park per Local Law 1 of 2004, and

<u>WHEREAS</u>, the Fee Schedule for park usage may be amended by resolution per Local Law 1 of 2004, section 2, sub-section E.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Town Board of the Town of Deerpark amends the current fee schedule as follows:

Applicants may use Space Park for private events at a non-refundable charge of \$50 per day. A refundable security deposit of \$100 must accompany the Facilities Use Application that is submitted to the Town Clerk for the use of the park. Not for profit organizations shall be exempt from the \$50 fee but still must submit the required security deposit. After any event, all garbage must be removed and all town property must be in its original form. If property is damaged, it must be reported to the Parks Maintenance Supervisor immediately. The security deposit will be refunded after a satisfactory inspection of the property and upon written approval by the Parks Maintenance Supervisor. The written approval is to be submitted to the Town Clerk. If the security deposit (\$100.00) does not cover the cost of the clean up or repair, the applicant/user

shall be held responsible for the additional costs. The town shall have the right to collect the additional costs by any legal means available to it.

This resolution shall take effect upon passage by a majority of the Town Board.
