

Effective Friday, September 1st at 1 PM and every quarter thereafter on the first Friday of the month, the emergency warning siren will be sounding in the Sparrowbush area for approximately four minutes. This will only be testing of the warning siren. (Later in 2018 it is expected the Cuddebackville area warning siren will come on line). In an actual emergency the warning siren will be sounded several times in four minute increments at which time individuals should contact Orange County 911 and/or the Town of Deerpark Emergency Operations Center @ (845) 856-E911 for information as to the type of emergency.

******NOTE: If it is a sudden emergency the Deerpark EOC may not be initially open.**

Example of emergencies but not limited to the following:

- 1. Dam emergencies**
- 2. Hurricane and severe weather related incidents**
- 3. Train incidents**
- 4. Hazardous materials incident**
- 5. Major forest/brush fire**
- 6. Any special natural or man-made catastrophic event**
