Deerpark Veterans Memorial Sparrowbush Park

Memorials symbolize a nation's memory! Memorials convey a society's recognition of sacrifices made on behalf of their county. It shows respect for losses that must never be forgotten!!

We, the Town of Deer Park Veteran Committee, have started a memorial to recognize all Tri-State Veterans, to honor all who served their country, as not only a war veteran but also those who have served during times of peace. The memorial will be constructed at the Sparrowbush Firemen's Park, Main St. Sparrowbush.

We have an approved plan that will consist of 50 foot circle, Protruding 18 inches above ground level. In addition there will be concrete and block piers 32" wide x 40" High, to honor all military branches with a memorial stone in the center. One name per paver.

Your help is needed to make this happen by purchasing a paver-type stone honoring your family members who served, past and present. An engraved paver with their name, rank, branch of service, unit etc. Cost is \$100 each.

The \$100 cost will help to cover the cost of the concrete structure. All pavers will be placed on the inside of the concrete circle with the new flagpole in the center.
