<u>98<sup>th</sup> District Assemblyman Karl Brabenec</u>, previous Town of Deerpark Supervisor gave an update. He thanked the Supervisor and board and said it was great to be back home. There are new things happening in the state. They had serious changes in the Assembly in regards to Mr. Sheldon Silver resigning from Speaker after 21 years. He is under investigation and pending the outcome, he will remain assemblyman until there is a verdict. Because of that situation, he has signed on to three different bills sponsoring to repeal the SAFE Act, legislation called the Apple Plan putting a moratorium on the Core Curriculum. There will be more bills regarding property tax reform, property tax exemptions. The Budget proposed is \$142 billion—probably one of the largest state budgets in the country. His office will bring together all the Districts towns Supervisor's Board Members to meet with DOT to discuss the infrastructure to meet needs in local towns April 2nd. He's always looking for input in how to better use funding. He is looking for a home rule for Deerpark and waiting for Sen. Bonacic to sponsor a bill in Senate, Court Officer to have a pistol in the court room position needs to pass the Senate and Governor. Any ideas for bills, just let him know. His office is at 123 Route 94 South in Warwick. They'll do local town halls eventually and be more accessible. He thanked the Supervisor for an opportunity to speak.
