RESOLUTION # 9 OF 2018 OF THE TOWN BOARD OF
THE TOWN OF DEERPARK, ORANGE COUNTY,
NEW YORK

2017 Local Laws re-numbered

WHEREAS, the Town of Deerpark adopted Local Law #1 of 2017, entitled "Local Law Delegating to the Chief of Police of the Town of Deerpark, County of Orange, State of New York, the Power and Authority to Request or Grant Police Assistance Pursuant to an Intermunicipal Agreement and Section 209-M (3) of the General Municipal Law of the State of New York"; and

WHEREAS, the Town of Deerpark adopted Local Law #2 of 2017, entitled "Local Law Creating a Moratorium of Development, Creation or Construction of Multi-Family Uses in the Town of Deerpark, Orange County, New York"; and

WHEREAS, the Town of Deerpark adopted Local Law #3 of 2017, entitled "Local Law Reducing the Number of Members from Seven (7) to Five (5) of the Deerpark Planning Board in the Town of Deerpark, Orange County, New York"; and

WHEREAS, the Town of Deerpark adopted Local Law #4 of 2017, entitled "Local Law Adopting a Real Property Tax Exemption in the

Town of Deerpark, Orange County, New York for Cold War Veterans
Authorized by Real Property Tax Law Section 458-b"; and

WHEREAS, the Town of Deerpark forwarded the above referenced
Local Laws to New York State Code; and

WHEREAS, the Local Laws submitted to New York State Code were
not received and/or processed by New York State; and

WHEREAS, the Local Laws identified above were adopted by the
Deerpark Town Board after Public Hearing; and

WHEREAS, all Local Laws identified above were adopted after all
proper procedures relative to adoption of Local Laws had been
complied with and completed; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary for the Local Laws to be renumbered so
that they can be included by New York State Code as Ordinances
adopted by the Town of Deerpark.

RESOLVED, that a Local Law previously introduced as Local Law #2 of 2018, entitled "Local Law Adopting an Application for Construction of Driveway Entrances and Exits, and an Acknowledgment/Agreement Relative to Construction of Driveway Entrances and Exits in the Town of Deerpark, County of Orange, State of New York", shall be renumbered, reintroduced, and hereinafter identified for potential adoption as Local Law #6 of 2018, entitled "A Local Law Adopting an

Application for Construction of Driveway Entrances and Exits, and an Acknowledgment/Agreement Relative to Construction of Driveway Entrances and Exits in the Town of Deerpark, County of Orange, State of New York".


