RESOLUTION #5 OF 2010 CURTAILMENT OF UNNECESSARY EXPENDITURES DURING REMAINDER OF CURRENT FISCAL YEAR 2010

WHEREAS pursuant to §§ 29 and 103 (2) of the Town Law of the State of New York, the Budget Officer after consulting with all other Town Council members has notified the Town Council that it appears probable at the current rate of expenditures that the moneys available for fiscal year 2010 may either be insufficient to meet the amounts appropriated or in the alternative leave an exceedingly small surplus to be applied to the 2011 budget, and

WHEREAS the Budget Officer, after consulting with all other Town Council members has recommended that the Town Council reduce spending for the remainder of the current fiscal year,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Town Council of the Town of Deerpark in regular session duly convened as follows:

- Each department head, prior to the expenditure over \$250.00 of any Town funds appropriated for fiscal year 2010, shall obtain the written authorization of the Budget Officer and the Town Board before incurring any expenditure other than salaries of officers and employees and obligations previously authorized by contract or the Town budget for 2010.
- 2. This resolution shall take effect immediately.
