April Supervisor's Update

SENIOR SHUTTLE UPDATE: The Town Board has voted to send out a request for proposals (RFP) for organizations and individuals to bid on running our Senior Shuttle Service. Our goal is to provide expanded and better service at an equal or lesser cost to the taxpayers of Deerpark. Proposal deadlines are April 15th and we will update you on new developments in my next report.

BULK CLEAN UP DAY: The Deerpark Bulk Clean Up Day will be held on **Friday, May 13th** and **Saturday, May 14th** at the Port Jervis Transfer Station during their normal business hours. If you are a Deerpark resident or business, you may participate and bring in various bulk items up to 4 cubic yards per permit. Each household or business is entitled to one permit which should be obtained at the Deerpark Town Clerk's office. For a listing of acceptable items or any questions, please visit our web site or call 856-2210, ext. 2.

REVIEW OF TOWN CODES: During the first Town Board meeting in April, I have asked Councilman David Hoovler and our Town Attorney Bill Bavoso to do a comprehensive review of all codes and local laws in the town to see if there is anything that is out-of-date or needs changing due to the times we are living in today. They will be coming back to the board with a report shortly. If anyone has any suggestions on any laws that should be modified, please e-mail my office at kbrabenec@townofdeerpark.org and I will pass along the information for the report.

ENERGY EFFICIENCY GRANT: I am proud to announce that the Town of Deerpark has been

awarded \$52,000 by Orange County for an ARRA Energy Efficiency Project at Town Hall. This money is part of the federal stimulus program and will be used to upgrade most of the windows at Town Hall. Over time, the town will realize cost savings with air conditioning and heating costs. Special thanks go to our Town Clerk Flo Santini, Orange County Legislators Dennis Simmons and Melissa Bonacic and Town Engineer Al Fusco for letting us know about the program and helping us to apply for the grant.

MODEL COMMUNITY: Deerpark has been named as a "Model Community" by the New York State Association of Towns. This was in response to our recent reforms in our Emergency Preparedness Law. This particular law has been highlighted and recommended by other towns in the state to adopt. In addition, officials from the Town were asked to make a presentation on the law during the annual Association of Towns Conference this past February. Good work goes to Councilman Hoovler who spearheaded this effort and Joyce Cirulli, who helped us at the Conference!

FREE RABIES CLINIC: Our DCO, Thomas Yonskie will be organizing a free rabies clinic on Sunday, May 15th, Noon to 3 pm. The location will be at Huguenot Fire Company on 431 Route 209 and the event will be open to residents of Deerpark, Port Jervis, Greenville, and Mount Hope. Call 845-321-7172 for more information.
