### **March Supervisor's Update**

ELECTION DISTRICTS 3 & 5: The Town Board has recently amended the boundary lines of Election Districts 3 and 5. We changed the boundary because, since 1996, voters that live on the northern portions of Upper Brook Road, Academy Avenue, Old Cahoonzie Road, and Boehmler Road have been forced to drive to Building #2 in Huguenot to vote rather than right down the road to the Sparrowbush Fire House. We are happy to make this change in efforts to make voting easier and more accessible.

POLICE COMMISSION CHANGES: The Town Board has also recently passed a local law changing the structure of the Police Commission from a five member volunteer board to a three member volunteer board. In addition, it is mandatory that a member of the town board serves on the commission. This change was an effort to conform with state statutes and to improve communications and operations between the town board and police department.

SENIOR SHUTTLE UPDATE: In the next couple of months, we will be researching ways to find more cost savings and to improve operations and schedules with our Senior Shuttle Service. A request for proposals will be going out to re-bid these services that we provide. The board will analyze all the bids when we receive them and choose a vendor that will provide quality service to our senior population. This service hasn't been bid out in over 20 years, so we are confident we will be able to find a cost savings while providing better and more accessible service.

BULK CLEAN UP DAY: As promised, the

return of the Deerpark Bulk Clean Up Day is imminent. We are negotiating with Orange County Environmental Services to provide a clean up day at the Port Jervis Transfer Station for our residents. The tentative date is May 13th and 14th. More details will appear in next month's issue.

**HEALTH INSURANCE CHANGES: We** have started to change over the town's health insurance carrier to not only provide cost savings for town taxpayers, but also to provide better coverage for our full time employees. Recently, the Town Supervisor, Town Clerk, and Highway Superintendent have switch health insurance providers from NY-SHIP (Empire Plan) to MVP. Switching to this insurance will save town taxpayers an estimated \$12,000 a year, just on these three individuals. In the coming months, we will be negotiating with our Highway and Police Department employees to switch as well. I will update you on our progress in future reports.

PAPERWORK REDUCTION: The town has recently leased two new copier, scanner, fax machines in an effort to consolidate our printing equipment, and cut down on paper usage by utilizing scanning, e-mail, and the Internet. By buying less ink cartridges and using less paper, the taxpayers will realize a potential annual cost savings of about \$3000. In the coming months, we will be phasing out the old equipment, selling many of those items and utilizing our web site to provide more information and forms at your disposal.
