They are careful how they spend the money and are out of deficit financing. Now they need to maintain it. <u>Supervisor Spears</u> stated they were at a levy of 1.94%, which is under the 2% tax cap. It is a little higher than in the past, but they are getting caught up with their 2% raises every year for their unions, just to be able to pay all the police officers and highway guys. They have been getting good news about the sales tax being up, so if they have money, it will go in the Unreserved Fund Balance and hopefully they can return some or at least keep it low next year. There were no questions.
