Closing Board Comments

<u>Councilman Smith</u> – He said it was a great year behind them. They effectuated some good changes and said Gary did a good job on the budget. He thanked him very much. He also stated that everybody on the board did a good job.

<u>Councilman Schock</u> – He said he doesn't see as much of what goes on here, but from what he sees it appears to be harmonious and there is not a lot of turmoil. He was impressed with the Highway Department and what they did this year. They blacktopped the most miles and that is great for the citizens. He thanked Gary for his budget work. He was thankful for Ms. Cassas 13 years—that was quite a stretch and they should pray for her health.

<u>Councilman Smith</u> asked the Supervisor if the Ambulance Service was given their second check. He said he would comment during his closing comments.

Supervisor Spears - He said he went to the Ambulance Service Re-organization Meeting and their one director, Mike Diamond resigned. He took a full time job as a paramedic, which he is and it would have been a step back for him to stay on as an EMT employee. George Ewings has been conducting interviews to get back to full strength with EMT's and has a list of who he is hiring. He will contact Kelly Decker and get the final payments and contact Matamoras to see whether they are going to be a part of the program with some kind of contribution. He'll report back to the board after he attends the Ambulance Board Meeting with their financials. Their collections are coming in and will show up in a month or two. Their insurances are paid. Councilman Smith asked what Matamoras might be contributing and Mr. Spears said it would have to be negotiated. He then said the town hall, highway and police employees are great and work hard and do their jobs. They are professional. Flo's office runs like clockwork. They have enough help in the Assessor's Office-they seem to also. Alfred's picking up the slack for Bob (Building Department) and Bob was in and is doing a little better. If his numbers come up, he thinks he'll go for the treatment. That's really good news and they wish him the best in the new year. He also gave his condolences to Flo in the loss of her sister. He thanked Danielle for doing such a good job. He reported on the Big Pond Road project saying it is completed and they have submitted the paperwork to get payment. They will have a meeting with FEMA. He thanked Glen and Al for their professional help this year. He was looking forward to the new year. Some bad news,,,they were counting on a big surplus in their snow overtime, salt and snow budget. November and December however, wiped that out. They will order salt for the new year any day.
